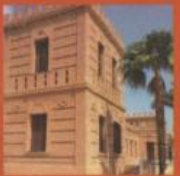

Programme

Day 1:

- You will be met at Alicante airport by our Tour Manager, and transferred by private coach to your hotel in Lo Pagan.
- In the evening you will meet with Pat Archibald at the hotel. Pat will introduce you to the range of projects and techniques on offer throughout the week.

Day 2 onwards:

- You will enjoy four days of quilt workshops soaking up Pat's expert knowledge and picking up lots of tips and tricks along the way.
- The larger patchwork project, offers an opportunity to learn more about combining and blending fabric colours.
- You can experiment with spun-bonded textiles (Lutradur), painted to suit your fabric colours, then cut it into lovely interlaced Celtic designs, to use as an atmospheric backdrop to silhouettes.
- Pat will also demonstrate using metallic bias binding to provide a different style of Celtic motif.
- Other techniques include gilding and foiling fabrics to make statement brooches and using fabric tubes to make Celtic knot necklaces.
- Students can undertake one main project, or several, mixing and matching techniques as they wish to produce unique pieces by the end of the week. All projects are adaptable and flexible to individual needs and skill levels.
